
Guaranteed Admissions Agreement

- ▶ History of GAA
 - ▶ Present agreement
 - ▶ How it works
- 

GAA Eligibility

- ▶ Student must submit a Letter of Intent after completing at least 15 credits, but 90 days prior to graduation
- ▶ Minimum 2.50 GPA (currently being re-evaluated)
- ▶ Meet all requirements for program completion for transferrable associates or articulated applied associates degrees
- ▶ Enroll at ODU within one year of graduating from the community college
- ▶ C or better in classes applicable to the transferrable associates or articulated applied associates degrees

Letter of Intent Process

- ▶ At 15 credit completion or 90 days prior to graduation, students may submit a Letter of Intent
 - ▶ Purpose of the Letter of Intent
 - ▶ How our Letter of Intent is different than other four year institutions
 - ▶ What students can expect
 - ▶ Who submits a Letter of Intent?


Articulation Agreements

- ▶ Community college programs: applied associates degrees and some transferrable degrees (for professional study majors)
- ▶ ODU: Engineering Technology, Health Sciences, Human Services, Criminal Justice, STEM, Teacher Prep, Nursing and Dental Hygiene
- ▶ How do applied associates degrees get articulated?
 - ▶ GEC + AAS/AAA degree = ODU Articulation


Certificate in General Education

- ▶ Each institution's certificate is different
- ▶ ODU requirements
- ▶ Completion of certificate with applied degree as negotiated in the articulation agreements will waive lower division general education at ODU.
 - Students receive the same benefit as if they completed the transferrable associates degree
- ▶ Certificate must be completed at the same time so that the student graduates with both!


